

• Art on the Spot: Kids contest – one hour to create a unique work of art using just recycled materials.

• Going Green: Junior crafts with Going Green focus made out of toothpicks, tongue depressors, straws, string and recycled items.

• **Recycled Glass Art**: Create a work of art using recycled glass. (Pieces of colored glass or glass that is fused, slumped, carved, etc.)

• Backyard Compost: bring 3-4 pounds of your compost, along with description and photo of compost bin used






More Green : Plants & Landscaping

















Marketing Plays A Vital Role

- Presentations to Parent & Teacher Organizations
- Place Handbook in local newspaper
- Survey youth to find out what interests them
- Reach out to Summer Camps

Marketing Plays A Vital Role

- Direct Marketing to the <u>Right</u> <u>People</u>
- Sign-up <u>at the fair</u> with interest for next year (i.e. Guest Book)



Marketing Plays A Vital Role

- Reminder postcard to prior exhibitors when information is available on-line
- Direct contact with Schools arts, vocational courses, etc.
